The TEAM Business & Community Network meets 3 times a year to discuss partnership approaches to supporting children and young people in the communities served by TEAM Education Trust.

At Business & Community Breakfast meetings, representatives from the Trust and its schools meet with local business leaders and community interest groups to network and discuss pledges that meet the Trust and School priorities. Those 'levelling up' priorities are driven by TEAM's drive to be inclusive to all pupils.
